Swansea University has completed constructing the new £450 million Bay Campus, a 65-acre site on the seafront.

The site, which opened in September 2015 and accommodates over 1,500 students, includes a £32 million 700-seater auditorium called the Great Hall, an arts centre, halls of residence, academic faculties and a library.
